As a PROM/SE representative for your building, we would like to enlist your help in completing a critical piece of this project. Collecting complete buildingspecific data sets are essential in providing you with the types of in-depth reports we cover in this institute.

You can assist us by the answering questions from the teachers in your building and encouraging them to complete the online PROM/SE teacher survey if they have not already done so. 1. Completing our teacher lists

The list is for you to take to your building and assist teachers who have not completed the online survey. <u>Online completion of the teacher surveys is strongly encouraged.</u> Your list has teacher names, passwords, and logins. Your teachers will be compensated \$25 for logging in and completing the survey (\$15 for the paper background questionnaire and \$10 for each online teacher survey completed).

3. Help with Paper Questionnaires & Surveys

Teachers who have not completed the <u>background questionnaire</u> can still do so (paper-only). In this packet, we have provided grade-specific paper copies for reproduction. Please make a copy and have the teacher complete it.

Additionally, if a teacher is unable to log in and/or access the <u>teacher survey</u> via the Internet, we have provided paper copies that you may duplicate and give to them.

For your convenience, we included a self-addressed envelope to the PROM/SE offices. Please use this envelope to return paper questionnaires and surveys to us or, if teachers prefer, they can mail us their responses individually. Please ask your building administrators to provide postage.
